

Vincent Strumolo, CEO, CCO, LMFT

Biographical Summary

Mr. Vincent Strumolo has been working in the trauma, mental health, and addictions arena since 1990. He is currently the Chief Executive Officer (CEO), Chief Clinical Officer (CCO), and co-founder of Resolutions Healthcare LLC. He was formerly the CEO at the Treehouse, a 180 bed Addiction Campuses facility in Scurry, Texas. He has also held the positions of Clinical Director at Alternate Family Care, New Life and Life Changes Treatment facilities in Florida and The Greenhouse Treatment Center in Grand Prairie, Texas. He has also held the position of Director of Performance Improvement and Risk Management at psychiatric hospitals in California and Pennsylvania.

Mr. Strumolo has specialized in the treatment of childhood and adulthood trauma. His early trauma work was with Severely Emotionally Disturbed Children (SED) in a locked facility. He later crossed over to adults suffering from childhood or adulthood traumas/life events. He has gained extensive training through his experiences as a licensed therapist, crisis intervention therapist on the mobile crisis response team in Broward County and as a clinician. He also trained law enforcement personnel in Broward County, FL on Crisis Intervention Training (CIT).

Mr. Strumolo has co-authored a book chapter "A Non-traditional Treatment of Youth with Conduct Disorders" which was published in 1998 (Carolina Academic Press). He served as an advisor on the Board of Directors of the American Association of Children in Residential Centers, a member of the Broward County United Way Quality Assurance Committee and a faculty member of the Broward Steering Committee's Crisis Intervention Team (CIT).

Mr. Strumolo has consulted on and developed clinical programs that are "*Real Time*" and data driven at his psychiatric hospitals and more recently at his substance rehabilitation facilities. He designs clinical systems, performance improvement programs, utilization management programs, and clinical continuing education programs. He has held various Quality, Risk Management and Compliance positions at the senior leadership level for various psychiatric hospital organizations.

Mr. Strumolo has been a forward thinker in the field of post traumatic stress and has developed a framework for therapy called Resolution Focused Therapy© (RFT). RFT is an integrated and systemic approach in treating trauma and unresolved issues in life. Mr. Strumolo has been active in developing a comprehensive tracking, utilization management, and performance improvement program for the RFT system of care. This comprehensive system of care won recognition from Joint Commission on the Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations (TJC) when his previous employer received the 2001 Ernest A. Codman Award for performance improvement in behavioral healthcare.

Mr. Strumolo has performed workshops at many national and international Conferences: the American Association of Children's Residential Centers (Sannibel, Florida 1998) (Boston, Mass. 2004), the National Association of Children's Homes and Societies (Atlanta, Georgia 1998), the CHARPP Conference, "Real Time Real Data" (Portland, Oregon 2001, 2004), and the JCAHO behavioral conference (Chicago 2001). He has lectured at Cornell University's "Second Annual International Conference of the Residential Child Care Project" in Dublin Ireland on April 27, 2005.

In Florida, Mr. Strumolo conducted a series of workshops on the use of RFT as a system of care for trauma in Gainesville, Tampa, Miami and Ft. Lauderdale. He has conducted lectures on sexual and physical abuse, trauma and substance abuse, treatment planning and performance improvement systems of care at numerous locations such as Linking Forces Seminar in Miami, Florida Council on Mental Health in Orlando, Broward County Resource Fairs, St. Thomas University in Miami and Barry University in Miami Shores.
